Our Lady of Lourdes is a single stream co-educational primary school located in Dardanup, approximately 20 minutes from Bunbury. With a current enrolment of 221 students from Kindergarten through to Year 6, the school is part of an active Parish and local community, with strong partnerships with families. These roles are to support students, in collaboration with the classroom teachers.

- Education Assistant to support students in Junior Primary and facilitate other intervention programs (Multi-Lit in 2018) Monday to Thursday 8.30am-3.20pm

Selection criteria:

- Be fully supportive of the objectives and ethos of Catholic education.
- Be willing to work constructively and positively with teacher direction.
- Work collaboratively as part of a team with other staff.
- Have excellent interpersonal and organisational skills.
- Have sound literacy, numeracy and IT skills.
- Demonstrate initiative, flexibility and the ability to work independently.
- Display a high degree of professionalism and confidentiality.
- Display a committed and enthusiastic approach to working with students and the ability to develop positive relationships.
- Be willing to contribute to the life of the school beyond the immediate classroom role.
