We have had a busy term in Pre-Primary!

In Literacy Dedicated Time we continue to consolidate phonological skills and are becoming more confident in sounding out words in our writing. We have been learning some high frequency words to assist in our reading and writing. We have been learning poems written by Jill Eggleton. In these poems, we discuss unfamiliar words, sentence structure and the importance of comprehension.

In Mathematics, we have been consolidating our skills in subitising, number recognition and counting. We have been learning about formal and informal measurement, and making and interpreting data from picture graphs.

In Health we have been learning about friendly and unfriendly behaviour. Students have participated in role play scenarios about how they could react in different situations.
