### **Board**

Our building project is continuing with the concrete slabs and the frames for the roof and walls completed over the holiday break. This term the Board will be involved in Strategic Planning to guide the direction for our school in the next few years. Next Board meeting is Tuesday 24 July at 5.30pm in the Staff Room.

### **P&F**

The Bull and Barrel Festival is coming up in October. The school assists this community event as a fundraising opportunity. We are looking for expressions of interest in becoming involved as a coordinator for the parking for this event.

The P&F are very generous in their support of our students. So far this year, they have contributed \$10 000 towards the refurbishment and upgrade of our Library including replacement of shelving. They have also contributed towards supporting the learning program in each class by providing for a teacher 'Wish List'. Everyone is invited to attend P&F meetings to be part of decision making regarding ways to support school initiatives. The P&F are currently in the process of purchasing an iPad for each classroom teacher to use in their classroom to take photos, and to prepare for teaching the digital technologies curriculum in their classroom.

Next P&F meeting is Thursday 2 August at 9.00am, all are welcome.

### **Term 3 Calendar**

### **Swimming Lessons**

Swimming Lessons will be held for two weeks this term in week 5 & 6. Notes are coming home today with students.

### **Year 6 Camp and Year 5 Camp**

Our Year 6 students are heading to Perth on September 4 for their camp. Activities include Kings Park visit, Scitech, Team Building, Indoor climbing, Caving, Crate climb/big swing, Archery, Abseiling, Flying Fox, Fremantle prison tour and other activities. Year 5 students will have an overnight surf camp in Term 4, where the emphasis will be on leadership skills and activities, as well as an MJR focus, where they will engage in a surfing opportunity to assist in their understanding that there are many 'God Moments' in our lives.

### **Banner**

A banner designed by students from our school will be on display in St Georges Terrace in the Perth CBD for one week next month, to represent the Shire of Dardanup in an annual art competition.

The Banners in the Terrace Competition is run annually by the WA Local Government Association and includes an exhibition of 80 banners showcasing the diverse range of local government areas across the State. Banners are designed to represent the city or shire in which they are made. The Dardanup banner will be on display for a week from Sunday, July 22. Following the competition, the school's banner will be displayed publicly by the Shire of Dardanup with the hope of adding to the collection each year.

Well done to our students on their creative design.

### **LEAD Awards**

Each year, Catholic Education WA offers the opportunity for schools to make application for LEAD Awards for excellence. The awards can be submitted in 4 categories: Learning, Engagement, Accountability and Discipleship (LEAD). We made application for three awards this year. In the Engagement category, we submitted an application for our Nature Play Project, celebrating excellence in how we engaged our community to work together to provide a play space that engages students in creative play. We applied in the Discipleship category for our Artwork Project where our Year 6 students for the last two years have been involved in creating an artwork in their final year of Primary School that celebrates an important aspect of our school, being the mural of our values in 2016 and the mosaic of our motto in 2017. We also applied in the Learning category for the introduction of Science as a specialist learning area, and the integration of Design Technologies and STEM learning.

I am delighted to say that we WON the award for Excellence in the Learning category, and will receive a cheque for \$4000 to further our work in that area. There are only 8 awards across the Catholic Education system, so we are extremely proud to be recognised out of all the entries received. The Leadership Team will be attending the award presentation ceremony in the next few weeks.

Mailing satchels are just one of the items you can bring to school to contribute to our recycling program.



We accept Prepaid Mailing Satchels and Padded Satchels

To make recycling even easier, Australia Post's satchels now include the Australian Recycling Label (ARL), an easy-to-understand label that indicates the satchel's recyclability and helps you learn more about mailing satchel recycling.

In order to recycle this waste stream properly, please make sure all excess product has been removed (i.e. letters & mail).

What happens to the waste?

Once collected, we pass them on to a cooperating agency. The mailing satchels are then cleaned and melted into hard plastic that can be remoulded to make new recycled products.
