There has been some interest expressed regarding out of school hours care, and whether this may be a possibility in conjunction with Dardanup Primary School. Our school has been in contact with DPS and at the moment this is in very early exploratory stages. There are many considerations to be made including which external provider, a designated space (available from 2.30pm for a provider to set up for after school care), cost, commitment of families and the possibility of casual or regular use and whether or not it is possible for the two schools to combine for an outside hours service due to the difficulty of transport between the two schools. I will keep you informed.

## Year 3

## Year 6

The Year 6 class has made a great start to Term 3. We thoroughly enjoyed the Maths Incursion, learnt a lot at Lifeskills for Life and can't wait to see Beauty and the Beast after participating in the drama workshop on Friday.

In English, we are doing novel studies in our reading groups and writing a historical narrative about migration in Australia's history.

In Maths, we have been learning all about area and perimeter and converting units of measurement. Our focus in Geography this term is Asia, we have started by locating Asian countries and their capital cities in an atlas.

## Pre Primary

One of our inquiry topics for this term is "How are we the same and how are we different?" We have been lucky to have visitors from France and America talk to the class about their countries. The class has enjoyed discovering different cuisines that are eaten in other countries and how language differs from ours.

This week we began wondering about how images change when they are magnified. The class was presented with an image that they had to guess what it could be. The students wrote down their ideas and at the end of the session they were told what it was. If you are interested come and have a look in our class and see what your guess is!

## Kindy

We are busy learning about the Ocean and the animals that live in the sea. We loved seeing first hand how a squid uses its ink to protect itself.

## Year 1

Last week the Year 1's performed the assembly item of 'The Smile That Went Around the World'. We learnt how valuable a simple smile can be. We worked really hard to learn our lines, and the words and actions for the songs. We were a bit scared but we still had so much fun.

## Year 2

Year 2's continue to be amazing and excited about learning. This term has seen us begin with a drawing incursion with Jason from Kaboomtoons, who has helped us to improve our skills.

We have been working really hard on learning something new every day.

We have been learning to program robots and write codes and build our own games.

We have just received letters from our pen pals and now we are busy replying.

## Year 4

We have been very busy in Year 4. We have started looking at recounts and sentence structure - did you know that there are different types of sentences? We went on a scavenger hunt in the classroom and found examples of simple, compound and complex sentences. In Maths, we are learning all about decimals and we are getting pretty good and ordering them. Our assembly is coming up soon so we are busy rehearsing for that too - there aren't enough hours in the day!

## Year 5

We have made a fantastic start to Term 3! Last Friday we participated in a Drama workshop conducted by Bunbury Catholic College. We thoroughly enjoyed the activities based around 'Beauty and The Beast'. It has certainly made us look forward to going to see the College's production of the play.

In Literacy we are writing procedural texts. We have created 'Revolting Recipes'..... some of which are thoroughly GROSS!

In Maths we have been looking at two dimensional shapes, transformations, symmetry and enlarging.

We are going tree planting this Friday as part of National Tree Day. We will be involved in the revegetation of a flat, sandy site within our Shire.
